DID YOU KNOW?

Pike and lake trout of Scott Lake and surrounding fly out lakes are slow growing and can be quite old. Aging studies by biologists from the British Columbia Institute of Technology determined a pike of 36" was 16 years old; a 28" lake trout aged at 22 years. In 2018 a 44" pike, hooked deeply and died was aged at 32 years.
